

Today, Banco de Portugal publishes statistics, in Table <u>A.25</u> of the *Statistical Bulletin* and in BP*stat*, on issues of debt securities and shares for June 2018.

In the first half of 2018, net issues (gross issues minus redemptions) of securities by residents totalled $\[\in \]$ 7.0 billion. This amount is mainly accounted for by positive net issues of debt securities, worth $\[\in \]$ 5.2 billion (Chart 1).

By institutional sector, the general government stood out, recording positive net issues of \in 5.3 billion (Chart 2). Conversely, non-financial corporations recorded negative net issues of \in 0.2 billion.

At the end of the first half of 2018, the outstanding amount of securities issued by residents totalled €463.6 billion (Chart 3), as a result of an increase of €8.0 billion compared with the previous six-month period. In addition to the contribution of net issues by the general government, the non-financial corporate sector stood out, with an increase of €2.1 billion explained by a valuation of securities, which more than offset the negative net issues of this six-month period (Chart 4).
