Non-financial sector indebtedness July 2018

20 September 2018

Today, Banco de Portugal publishes statistics, in Table [A.20](#) of the *Statistical Bulletin* and in *BPstat*, on non-financial sector indebtedness for July 2018.

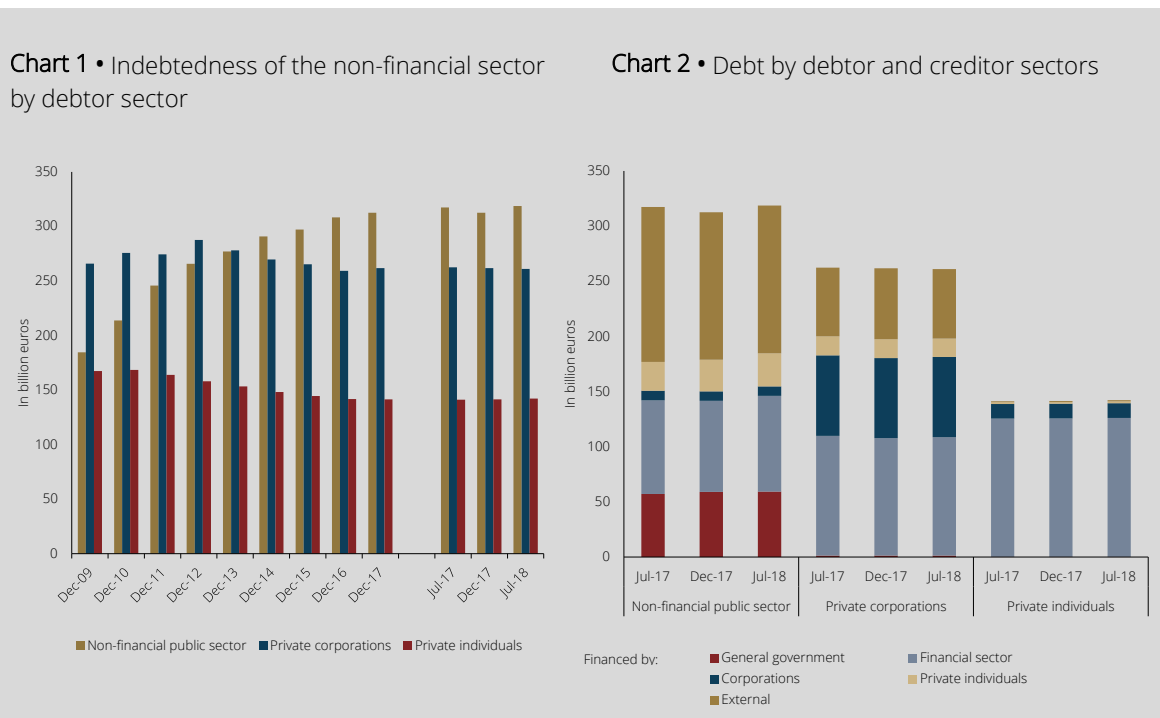
In July 2018, non-financial sector indebtedness stood at €721.9 billion, of which €318.7 billion related to the public sector and €403.2 billion to the private sector.

Compared to June 2018, non-financial sector indebtedness increased by €0.7 billion, chiefly due

to a rise in public sector indebtedness (Chart 1).

The rise in public sector indebtedness was reflected in an increase in financing granted by the financial sector and by private individuals, partly offset by a decrease in external financing and in financing obtained from the general government (Chart 2).

Private sector indebtedness remained virtually unchanged from the previous month.
