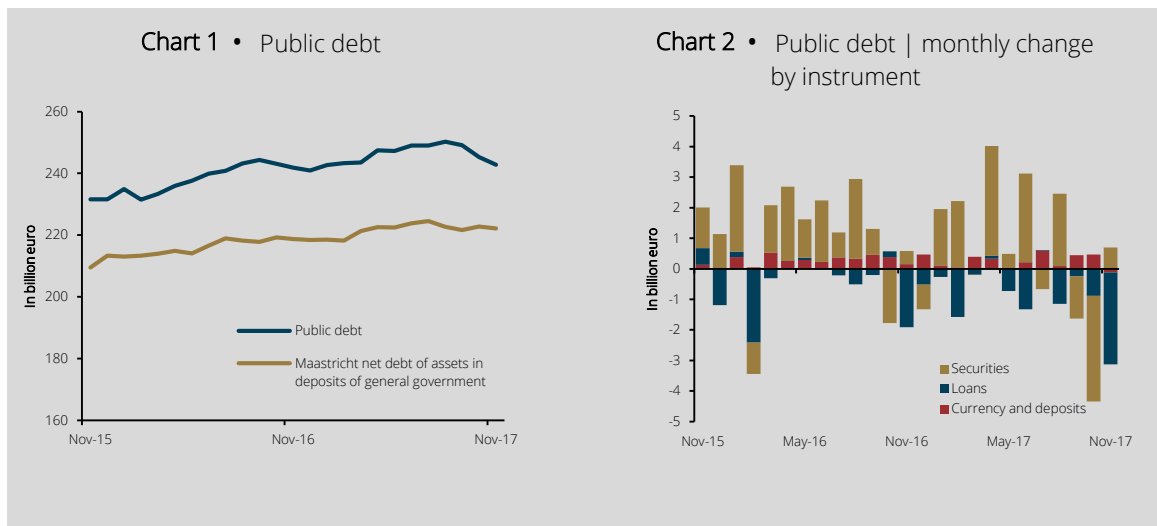

Today, Banco de Portugal publishes statistics, in Table [A.15](#) of the *Statistical Bulletin* and in *BPstat*, on public debt for November 2017.

In November, public debt stood at €242.8 billion (Chart 1), a decline of €2.4 billion from the end of October (Chart 2). This change chiefly reflects the

early repayment of IMF loans (€2.8 billion).

General government deposits declined by €1.8 billion. Therefore, public debt net of general government deposits decreased by €0.6 billion from October, totalling €222.2 billion.
